

NetGear Router Port Forwarding Setup For iDVR-PRO

1. Log into your Netgear Router <http://192.168.0.1> (By Default Username: **admin**
Password: **password**)
2. Now Click “**Port Forwarding**” button on the left hand side of the page.
3. Click the “**Add Custom Service**” button.
